





Observations

- ► The rotation at the International Institute of Zoonosis Control, IIZC, was educative, insightful and interesting as it offers in-depth research training in infectious diseases.
- ► The One Health Concept being pioneered by IIZC is an integrated holistic way of interrogating disease causation by the animal pathogens to humans.
- ▶ The setting up, organizing, and implementing a command centre in the face of a disease pandemic was very educative and informative.
- The routine monitoring of the various food, water, drinks and agricultural products by the Sapporo Public Health Institute was informative too.
- The infection control teams at the University Hospital to control hospital diseases outbreaks was very educative.
- ► The tracking of the Anti-Microbial Resistance by the University Hospital microbiology department was very good.

Observations

- ► The designation of hospitals like NCGM to adequately deal with highly Infectious diseases like Viral Hemorrhagic Fevers example Ebola or Covid-19 was very educative.
- ► The equipping of isolation units with very high-tech equipment like ECMO, Extra Corporeal Membranous Oxygenation, diagnostic equipment like Polymerase Chain Reaction was also was insightful and informative.
- The setting up a disease Surveillance and Intelligence unit to increase the levels of alertness for diseases was commendable. This way, diseases outbreaks do not take the country by surprise.
- ► There's need to explore areas of cooperation between the Universities, Research Institutions and Hospitals in Japan and Zambia so that researchers from Japan can come to Zambia to do research while Zambia students can study at Japanese Institutions for their graduate and post doctoral studies.

Observations

- This is the first time the Quality-of-Life Foundation is inviting a medical doctor from Zambia to participate in this very important program.
- ▶ In addition, this the first time the Quality-of-Life Foundation is having a medical doctor undertake training at International Institute for Zoonosis Control, University of Hokkaido and National Centre for Global Health and Medicine.
- Further this the first time, a rotation in Infectious diseases is being undertaken by the Quality-of-Life Foundation as opposed to cancer and oncology training.
- ▶ This being the case, I'm very privileged and honored to have been the first candidate to pioneer this infectious diseases training offered by the Quality-of-Life Foundation and partners.
